

Paul Gazzola is an artist, curator, dramaturg and educator working across performance, installation and site-based practices.

Over the last 20 plus years he has generated an innovative array of projects that have been commissioned and presented in Australia, Canada, Europe, Japan, South Africa, South America and the UK. His extensive working collaborations include such artists as Nadia Cusimano, Rosie Dennis, Kate MacIntosh, Xavier Le Roy & Meg Stuart and the companies Les Ballets C de le B (Belgium), Fieldworks Performance Group (Perth) and MACHINENOISY (Canada). He was also a founding member of Lone Twin Theatre (UK) creating the Catastrophe Trilogy that toured extensively in Europe between 2006 and 2010.
