Also, during his time with ADT Rowan worked with choreographer Alison Curry on 'Of All Things', 'North' by Ina Christel Johannesen, 'Immerse' by Adrianne Semmens, and 'Shapeless/Formless' by Felicity Boyd. Rowan has also appeared within two Adelaide Festival operas, Romeo Castellucci's rendition of Mozart's Requiem in 2021, and Barrie Kosky's The Golden Cockerel in 2022.
